## VSB Dog Policy

Please take some time to review the VSB's Dog Code, posted on the bright green signs along the fences. Dogs are only allowed on School Board property under the conditions noted on the signs.

Our school grounds and buildings are very active places with many children playing and moving about. Some children are afraid of dogs and/or allergic to them. School age children may put themselves at risk without thinking and get hurt by a dog. Unfortunately, dog feces have been left on our playgrounds, which is a concern for our students safety and hygiene when they engage in healthy outdoor play and as you can imagine it creates unpleasant odours. Allergic reactions, unhygienic situations arising from pet feces, and the possibility of unpredictable aggression contribute to the School District's decision to prohibit dogs in/on school properties during the school day.

**Please note: All children must be accompanied and supervised by a responsible adult.**

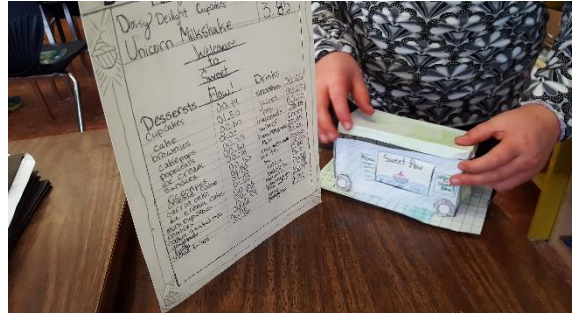


## Student Engagement and Learning

Poetry: Ms. Payson's, Division 3 class worked on Poetry Presentations. The students created a range of poems that were on display for two weeks in the C building. Small group tours for other classrooms (Ms. Bishop, Ms. Almeda, and Ms. Marshall) were held. As a class, Division 3, completed Found-Word poetry by going on a walk to Riley Park and generating a class vocabulary list. Poems were created in groups, pairs and/or on individually. Poems included 'Without You' poems, alliteration and simile poems, strict rule poems like Haikus and Limericks, biography poems with internal repetition, and visual alphabet poems.



Food Truck Fair: Division 3 created miniature paper food trucks after researching the food truck scene in Vancouver. Two events were held: one event just for students where they could 'order' food and students practiced their addition and subtractions skills using decimals, and a school-wide event where other classrooms, and even some parents, came to see Division 3's food trucks. Styles and types of food ranged from chili, macaroons, ice cream, lemonade, tuna bowls, and even an everything truck! Afterwards Division 3 celebrated with a potluck style lunch- well deserved!
