# Graham Bruce School News

## Traffic—Safety and Requests

During school days it is requested that parents/guardians respect the signs at the front of the school that state "No Parking, 8:00—5:00, Monday to Friday" and "No Stopping, 8:00—5:00, Monday to Friday". We have students attending our school that are in wheelchairs and their bus must have safe access to the school.

As a reminder to all parents and caregivers, the following regulations are in force during school times (8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday).



1. When school is in session, a 30-km/h school zone speed limit is in effect from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. every school day, unless otherwise posted. Also, remember that vehicles approaching from both directions must stop for school buses when their lights are flashing.
2. Do not stop or park on the wrong side of the street to drop off your children. This is becoming an increasing problem and poses significant risk to our children.
3. Always yield to pedestrians (it's the law). Pedestrians should cross at corners. Jay Walking or crossing in the middle of the block is very dangerous. **U-TURNS ARE ILLEGAL.**
4. When dropping off children in a school zone, stop and allow them to exit onto the sidewalk side of the car. **Never double park and allow a child to cross mid-block.**
5. If a vehicle is stopped in front of you or in the lane next to you, they may be yielding for a pedestrian, so be prepared to stop.

Please note that our school has partnered with the VPD, who will be randomly monitoring and ticketing drivers along Tanner and Moscrop Streets and in the surrounding area for road infractions. Thank you to those parents/guardians who comply with the rules of the road.

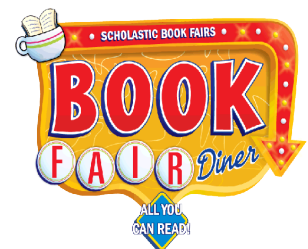
## Cellphones, Electronic Devices, Pokémon/Yugioh Cards



Electronic devices (such as cell phones, digital cameras and tablets) are a big part of our lives. They are also very expensive and can be lost or stolen easily. At Graham Bruce School, we encourage students to keep expensive belongings safe at home (this includes Pokémon & Yugioh cards, expensive toys, cell phones and electronic devices). For emergencies, students can access our office phone if they need to call home. Cell phones and electronic devices can be used by students for learning and communicating **with adult permission and supervision** at our school. We encourage students who use cell phones to use them outside of our school building before and after school. **We ask that all members of our school community (students, staff and parents/caregivers) refrain from using cell phones and ear buds in hallways and stairwells.** Hallways/stairwells, as well as recess and lunch breaks are for socializing, face to face communication and physical activity. **We also ask that parents refrain from communicating (e.g. calling and texting) students at Graham Bruce during instructional hours.** We also ask that parents refrain from using cellular devices in our hallways so that we "**walk the talk**" for our children. ## Scholastic Book Fair

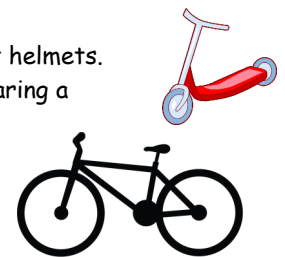
