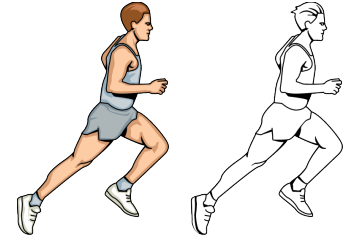

Please note that it is the responsibility of all parents whose child is participating in this team event that they take a turn at driving to and from the Meets. All Track Meets are held at Vancouver Technical Secondary located at 2600 East Broadway on the upper field.



Traffic—Safety and Requests

During school time it is requested that parents/caregivers respect the signs at the front of the school that state "No Parking, 8:00—5:00, Monday to Friday" and "No Stopping, 8:00—5:00, Monday to Friday". We have students attending our school that are in wheelchairs and the bus must have safe access to the school.

As a reminder to all parents and caregivers, the following regulations are in forced during school times (8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday).

1. When school is in session, a 30-km/h school zone speed limit is in effect from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. every school day, unless otherwise posted. Also, remember that vehicles approaching from both directions must stop for school buses when their lights are flashing.
2. Do not stop or park on the wrong side of the street to drop off your children. This is becoming an increasing problem and poses significant risk to our children.
3. Always yield to pedestrians (it's the law). Pedestrians should cross at corners. J-Walking or crossing in the middle of the block is very dangerous. **U-TURNS ARE ILLEGAL.**
4. When dropping off children in a school zone, stop and allow them to exit onto the sidewalk side of the car. **Never double park and allow a child to cross mid-block.**
5. If a vehicle is stopped in front of you or in the lane next to you, they may be yielding for a pedestrian, so be prepared to stop.



Please note that our school has partnered with the VPD who will be randomly monitoring and ticketing drivers along Tanner Street and in the surrounding area for road infractions. Thank you to those parents who comply with the rules of the road.

Please do not request a specific "teacher". Requests for a higher split grade (eg. 2/3 instead of 1/2) or a friend in the class, will be considered. Allergies & Medicines:

Please let the school know if your child has a very serious life-threatening allergy or if they regularly take medication so that we can discuss safety procedures with you. Medication may only be administered at school once a "Request for Administration of Medication at School" form has been completed by your child's attending Physician. Once this form has been completed by your Physician the medication will be kept at the school office and the child will see Denise to have the proper doses administered. Please do not allow your child/children to bring any type of medication to school for if it gets into the wrong hands a serious injury could occur.

Important Parental Reminders:

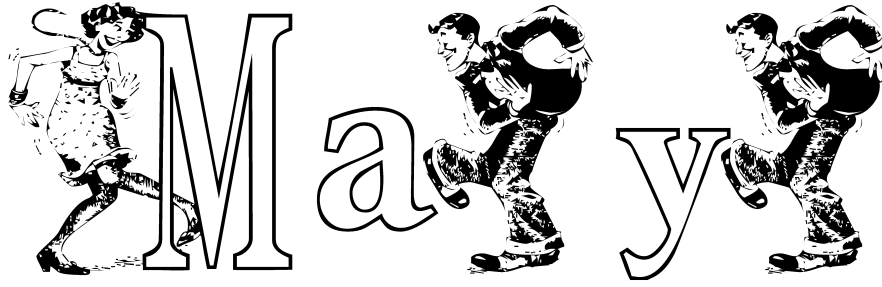
