3. **Proposed Catchment boundary changes**. Please visit the [VSB site](#) to familiarize yourself with the proposed changes to Cavell's catchment and provide your feedback. If you have younger children not yet enrolled in Cavell, the proposed boundary changes could impact your family. If your home no longer falls within Cavell catchment, as the proposal currently stands, younger siblings would not be granted priority for Cavell. This policy was a subject of great concern and debate at the May 24<sup>th</sup> District PAC meeting, and VSB planners were present to hear parent concerns. One concern was the belief the planning committee may not know the extent to which the lack of sibling priority in catchment change would impact families. The Planning committee putting forward proposed boundary changes for Vancouver elementary schools has responded to parent feedback and, since that meeting, has announced it will extend the review timeline and review current policies. This and other updates will be discussed at the PAC meeting. To complete the parent-created survey documenting numbers of affected families/younger siblings click [HERE](#) . These survey results will be provided to VSB as part of our community feedback regarding the proposal. DPAC is also carrying forward concerns regarding the sibling priority rule, based on a motion passed at the May 24<sup>th</sup> DPAC meeting.
