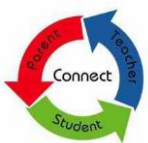
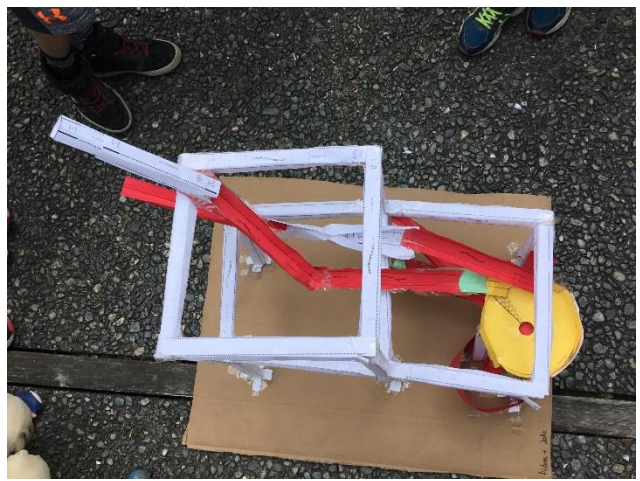
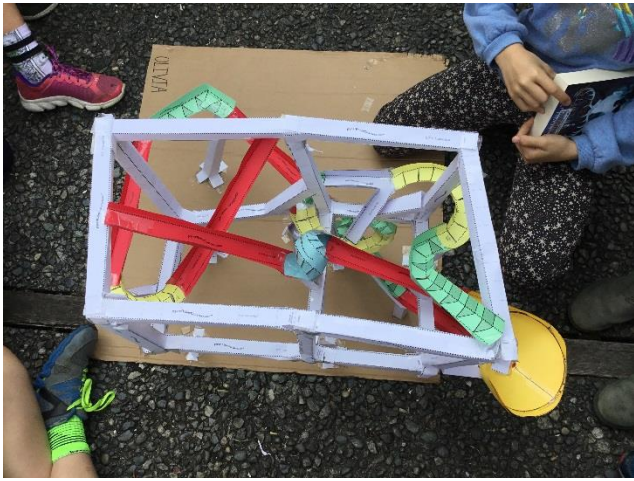
The Roots of Empathy program is looking for two babies to be "Teachers" for the upcoming 2018/2019 year at Carnarvon Elementary.
