- Students are in session from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

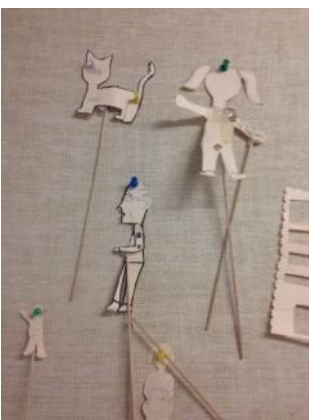

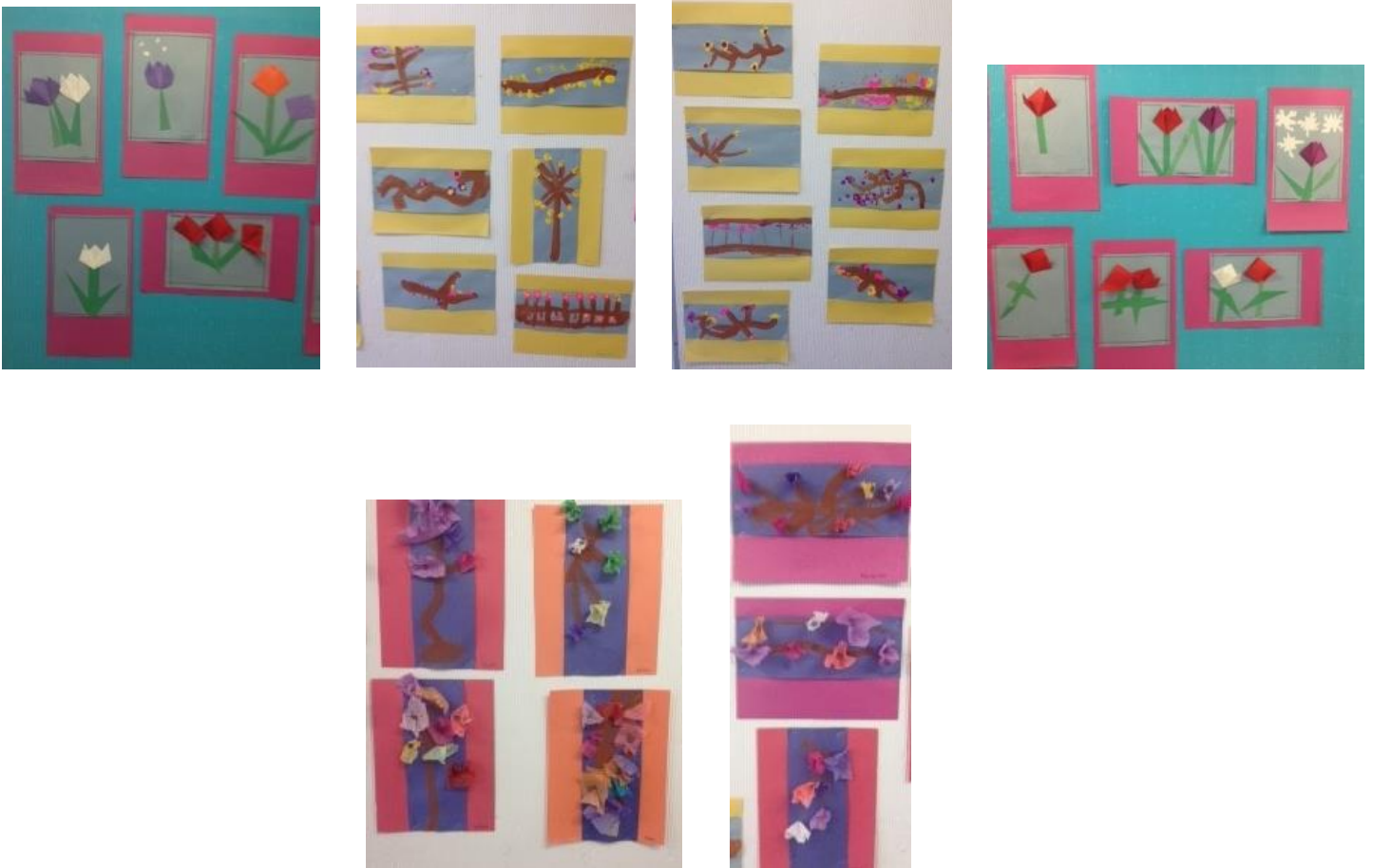
