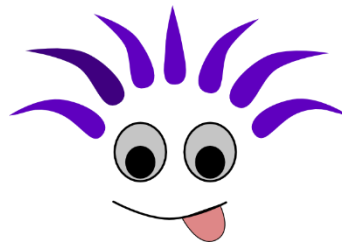

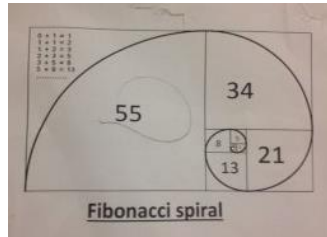
If you are looking for your baking trays and containers from donations to the Carnarvon Carnival Bake Sale, they are on display in the front hall for pickup. Thanks!

## SEYMOUR HATCHERY FIELDTRIP - DIV. 8 AND 9 (GR. 3/4)



On April 25, some of the students from Div. 8 & 9 visited the Seymour Hatchery in the Lower Seymour Conservation Area in North Vancouver. The students enjoyed a full day of outdoor experiments, including conducting a stream survey to determine the health of the habitat as a salmon-rearing area, and collecting and analyzing water samples to search for aquatic invertebrates. Students also got a behind the scenes tour of the hatchery, and they helped to feed the Coho fry in the outdoor ponds. Highlights of the day included wearing chest waders to get into the water and investigate the streams up close, and seeing the Steelhead eggs being collected from the live spawners at the end of the day.
