Over the next few weeks, there will be a lot of forms sent home to be filled out and signed. We would appreciate the return of the completed forms and any fees, as soon as possible.

Student Safety

One of our biggest priorities is the safety of your children.

1. Please make sure your child is picked up on time after school @ 3:00 p.m.
2. Please make sure you mark the dates on your calendar (paper or on your calendar on your phone) of our Professional Days and Early Dismissal days for parent conferences: October 18, 19 and January 31, Feb. 1. Dismissal times on these days will be 2:00 p.m.
3. Students are not allowed on our school grounds after 3:15 p.m. unless they are supervised by an adult or staying after school for a school-sponsored activity/class
4. Please model good pedestrian safety for our students by **NOT** jaywalking (crossing the road in the middle of the street). Please cross at a marked crosswalk.
5. Please do not park in the “No Stopping” and “No Parking” zone on 37th Avenue as this space is reserved for our school buses who transport our Special Needs students.

Reporting Student Absences:

Student safety is of paramount importance at the Vancouver School District. Ensuring student safety is a shared responsibility. In order to assist schools, we ask parents to notify schools of student absences. If your child will be absent from school, please phone the school to report this absence as early as possible. Parents should leave a message on a dedicated answering service by calling 604-713-5159, then, when prompted, enter extension 24. Messages will be received before the office is open. School offices are busy places: consistently notifying the school in advance of your child’s absence will significantly improve the efficiency and effectiveness of the Safe Arrival Morning Routine.

To Report Your Childs Absence – Please Call 604-713-5159, then, when prompted, enter extension 24 prior to 9 am on the first day of the absence.

Student Sign Out Procedure

When you pick up your child during the school day, please ensure that you sign them out at the school office. If you do not sign out your child, they will be unaccounted for, and the school will identify your child as a ‘missing’ student and will commence a search of school grounds. If the school staff do not locate the child, and are unable to reach a parent promptly, the school will call the Vancouver Police Department. Therefore, clear communication is essential for ensuring the safety of your child and to prevent unnecessary searches.

Thank you for helping us keep your children safe!

Valuables

The school cannot be responsible for valuable items brought to school by students. Please do not encourage your child to bring large amounts of money, expensive electronics, or irreplaceable sentimental items. If the child, after discussions with the parent(s) and teacher(s), decides to bring the electronic item (e.g. laptop, iPad, etc.) to the school to assist with classroom work, the school and/or staff cannot take responsibility for any damage or loss.

Medicine

For safety and liability reasons, students are not allowed to keep medicine in their classrooms. For children needing administration of an EpiPen or other medication, please contact the school office, as there are special forms to fill out in order for the medicine to be allowed on the school site. All medicine must be stored in our

office.

Supervision of Students

Students should not be arriving at school early unless they are attending a supervised sports or choir practice session, or their teachers have specifically requested a meeting. Supervision of students does not start until 8:40 a.m. Students are not allowed in any of our hallways until the 8:55 a.m. warning bell rings. If students and parents/caregivers arrive early, they are to:

1. Play or wait outside until the 8:55 a.m. warning bell
2. Go to the Activity/Lunchroom and wait quietly until the 8:55 a.m. warning bell
3. Go to the library (opens at 8:30 a.m. on specific days and not necessarily every day due to part-time schedule and/or staff meetings)

On dry weather days, we encourage all students to play and/or wait outside until the 8:55 warning bell.

PLEASE DO NOT WAIT IN THE HALLWAYS.

AFTER School

To ensure the safety of our students, all students are expected to be picked up or go home promptly at dismissal time, unless they are attending a supervised activity. **Students playing outside on the playground will not be supervised after 3:15 p.m. at which time parents/guardians/caretakers are expected to supervise their own children.** Students are not to be left unattended after 3:15 p.m. **Our school office does not provide babysitting services.** Parents are expected make their own child care arrangements should their schedules not allow them to pick up their children promptly at 3:00 p.m. dismissal time.

Hallways

Due to fire and safety regulations, we ask parents, caregivers, and students not to wait outside the classrooms and/or library before the start of the school day. This blocks our hallway access and disturbs meetings that are taking place in these rooms. Please do not stand in the library entrance way and block traffic.

Rainy or Bad weather Days

On dry weather days, students are expected to stay outside until the 8:55 warning bell. If it is raining or snowing, students may go to the Activity Room/Lunchroom to wait quietly starting at 8:40 a.m. Students may go to the library when it opens (see library door for schedule).

*****Please make sure your children are dressed appropriately for the cold and wet weather. On dry days, we will be asking students to go outside to play and enjoy the fresh air so they need to wear warm coats, jackets, hats, gloves, and boots if needed. On wet days, children should be wearing raincoats and boots and have an umbrella.**

Library

Ms. Cho will open the library on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday. The library will be officially open on Monday, September 11, 2017.

Homework: Read, Read, and Read some More!

We hope our students have continued the practice of reading daily over the summer. If you haven't done so already, now is a good time to start! If your child does not have homework, please encourage them to read for 20 – 30 minutes each day. Parents, please continue to take your child to our school library and the public library on a weekly basis to get new reading material. Although children should be allowed to choose their own reading material, encourage them to try something new like non-fiction books, magazines, audio books, etc.

Grade 7 – YWCA Program

Grade 7 students are invited to a highly recommended after-school YWCA program which will help them prepare for high school. Each Wednesday from October 18 – December 13, Gr. 7 students will meet for a snack, gym games, and discussions about healthy relationships, peer pressure, internet safety, media awareness, and other important topics. All Gr. 7 students will be meeting with the program leaders on Monday, September 25th. Registration forms will be sent home shortly thereafter. There will be a nominal registration fee will be **\$5.00**, a great bargain for 7 great sessions!

****Parent Traffic Concerns****

At Cunningham, we all work together to ensure your children arrive at our school, and depart from our school, safely. This past year, we have noticed parents not complying with traffic signs along 37th Avenue and stopping their cars in the “NO STOPPING” zones, making dangerous U-turns in the middle of the street, and crossing in the middle of the street instead of using a crosswalk. Also please DO NOT use the lane behind the school for drop off or pick up. Please help us by modeling good traffic safety for your children – remember that you need to model good behaviour for your children as they will copy what you do!
