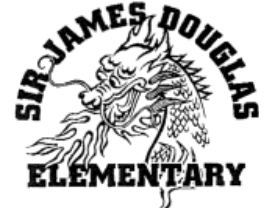

Safety when Picking-Up and Dropping Off Students

I know many drivers are parking on the south side of 60th Avenue, which is not a parking zone. Parking there also makes the street too narrow for drivers to go by. We are concerned about our students' safety and we would like to ask you to please 1) park only in the areas where parking is authorized and 2) make sure you model proper safety behaviour when you come to pick up your children.

We do not have sufficient bodies among our staff to patrol the South side of 60th as well as our school grounds. We will increase the amount of signage to remind you to park only on the North side of the street. In the fall, we will strive to put forward a parent patrol to make sure everyone remembers to follow the street signage and keep all of our students safe.
