## Principal's Message

Dear Nightingale Community,

Happy Spring to you all! I hope you enjoyed the first two weeks of Spring with family and friends, as we embark on the last three months of this school year. The staff is very happy to have our students back well-rested and relaxed. We look forward to many activities and events at our school in the coming months.

In order to facilitate a smooth transition to the last trimester of the school year, we would appreciate your support with the following:

**-School attendance:** The first morning bell is at 8:55am. Students should be in the classroom at 9:00am, ready to start a productive day of learning. Thank you to all of the families who are making an extra effort to ensure that students are developing a greater commitment to punctuality, so that class can get started right away.

**-Before/After school supervision:** School is in session from 9:00am to 3:00pm. The outside supervision takes place from 8:40am to 8:55am in the mornings and 3:05 to 3:20pm in the afternoons. On most mornings, our teacher-librarian, Mr. Doolan opens up the library at 8:30am for interested students. Our breakfast program starts at 8:30am. There is no supervision outside these hours for students who are dropped off too early at school. The safety of our students is our first priority, and we need your support to do our job well with the only resources we have available to us at this time. Thank you for your consideration and ensuring that your children are not dropped off at and picked up from school outside of the supervision hours.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank the Nightingale PAC for the amazing and tireless work they do for this community, from the monthly meetings to the Pub night and HAWK Night fundraiser events. **Our Pub Night Fundraiser Event is taking place on Friday, April 6<sup>th</sup>.** Please read the information provided in this newsletter about tickets and else. ## Second Step

### *SEL in Action*

This month, our schoolwide theme is problem solving. In our morning announcements and school assembly we'll be reminding students to use the *Second Step* Problem-Solving Steps:

- S: Say the problem
- T: Think of solutions
- E: Explore consequences
- P: Pick the best solution

As you can see, the first letter of each step spells the word "step." Remembering "step" helps students solve problems with each other in safe and respectful ways.

*Second Step* lessons specifically teach students to use each step and reinforce the message that solutions need to be safe and respectful. You will be receiving Home Links about the steps that describe why solving problems is important and including fun activities to do with your child to help him or her learn and practice the steps. We hope the steps will be helpful for you and your child when there are problems at home.

Please tell your child's teacher if you would like more suggestions about how to use the Problem-Solving Steps at home.

## Vancouver Board of Education SAFE ARRIVAL PROCEDURES

If your child will be absent from school, please call **604-713-5159** to report this absence as early as possible. Parents should leave a message at the dedicated answering service by calling the number provided. You will be prompted to provide the two-digit extension for your child's school to access the school's voicemail box for reporting an absence. The two-digit extension for Nightingale Elementary is **59**.

**It is important to report your child's absence prior to 9:00 a.m. on the first day of the absence.**

If your child is late for school they must sign in at the office before they make their way to the classroom. School offices are busy places: consistently notifying the school in advance of your child's absence will significantly improve the efficiency and effectiveness of the Safe Arrival Morning Routine.

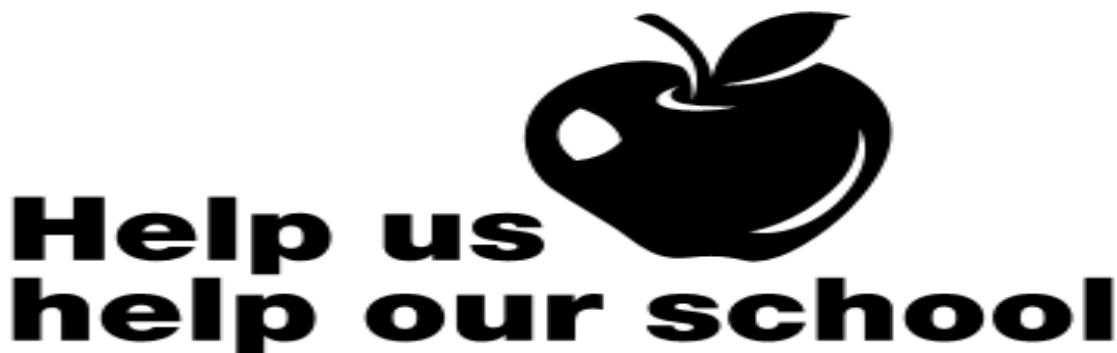
