Dear Gordon Parents,

It was so nice to see so many parents in attendance at our Meet the Teacher evening. It was particularly fortunate that the weather cooperated with the PAC picnic as well.

A very sincere thank you to all the parents who have made me feel welcome to Gordon. It always takes time to integrate into a new school for all stakeholders including parents, staff and the new Principal. Please continue to introduce yourselves and we do have a PAC meeting on September 24<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 pm.

I am really enjoying getting to know the students. I have visited the classes and also organized a short assembly where I introduced myself and showed the students a short fun video with an underlying message. I asked the students to share their perspective on what that message was. I was very impressed with the feedback that they shared including sharing the word “perseverance”.

### **Drop Off and Pick Up**

#### Parents

Our biggest concern at these times of the day is SAFETY. The front of the school on Bayswater is a DROP OFF ZONE only; that means that drivers cannot leave their cars, they can stop and let the student out of the car and then continue on.

Please do not Drop Off and Pick Up at the dead end of 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue nor in the alley behind the staff parking. There is parking on 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

#### Students

We really encourage parents to park a block away and walk in.

All students are to line up at the beginning of the day in the area designated by their teacher. The teacher and the SSA will meet the students at the line-up and will go up to the class with all the students; therefore, we encourage all parents to be on time.

#### A few tips from our Supervision Aides

All students should be dressed for the weather. For the younger students it is advisable to have an extra change of clothes in case of an accident. It is also very helpful if students have their names in their clothing. It really helps the Super V's to return items left outside to students.

#### A few tips for our Teachers

Teachers really enjoyed meeting and sharing classroom routines with the parents of their students. If you were not able to attend please take a moment in the near future to introduce yourself to your child's teacher. If you are intending on being away for an extended period of time please let the office know. It is also important to know that teachers are not responsible for preparing a homework package for the student. Just for your information going forward, teachers do not write letters of recommendation for application to private schools.
