Vancouver School Board Elementary School Attendance Area Boundaries

Vancouver School Board proposes to change some elementary school attendance area boundaries, the geographic areas that determine how students are assigned to each school. The school district determines these attendance areas so that the student population is balanced with the classroom capacity of each school.

The proposed changes would come into effect in September 2019. Students currently enrolled at any of the impacted schools are not affected.

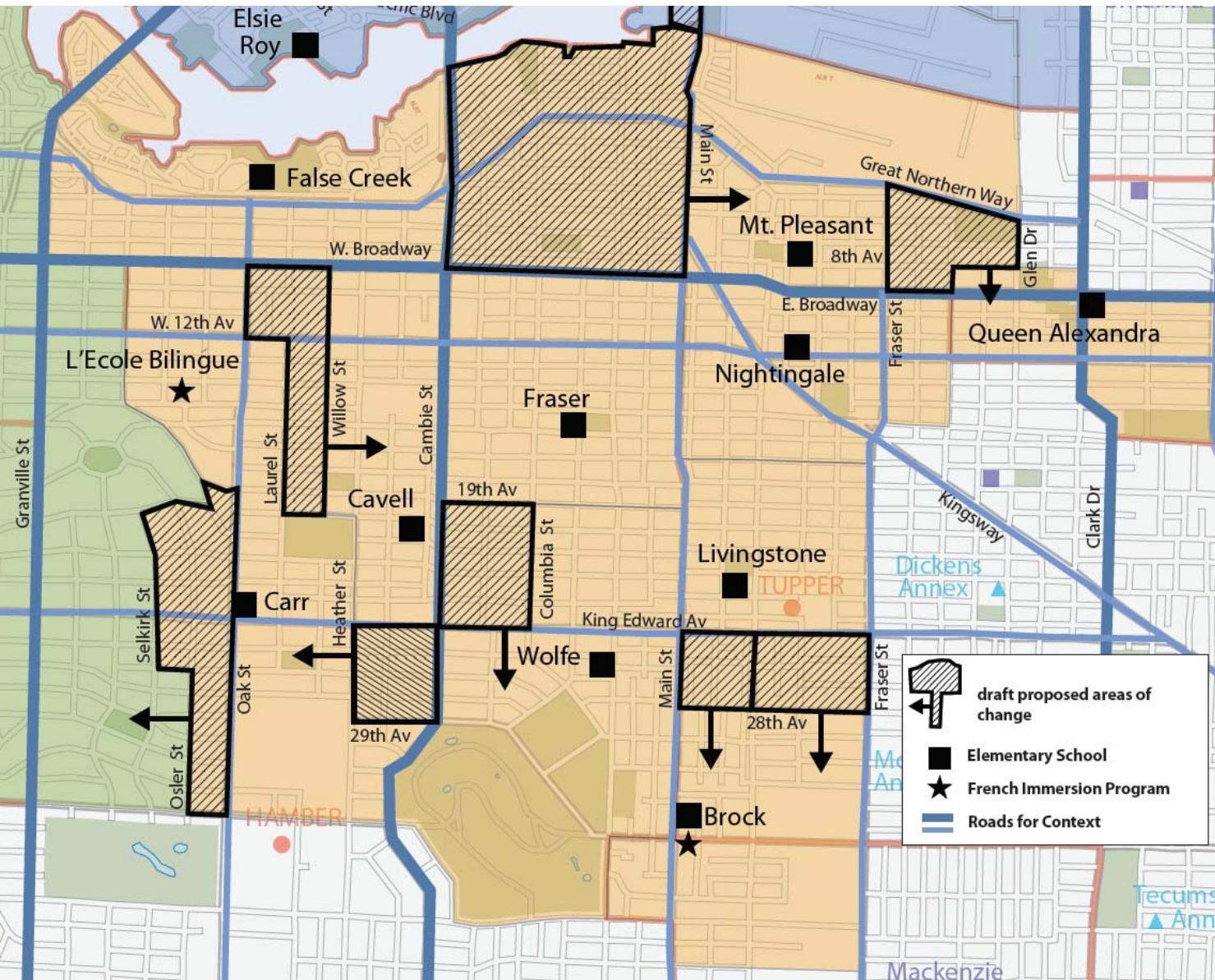

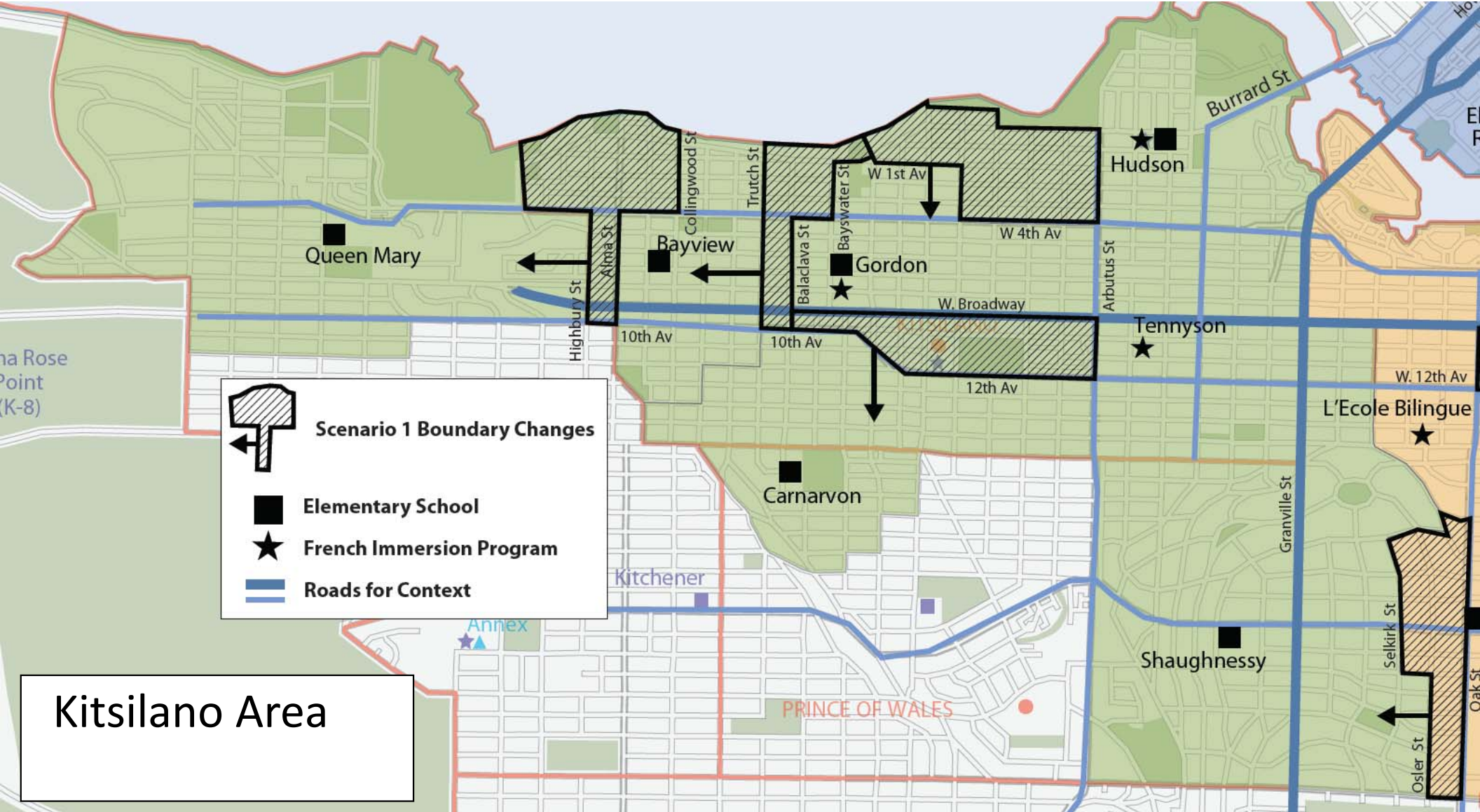

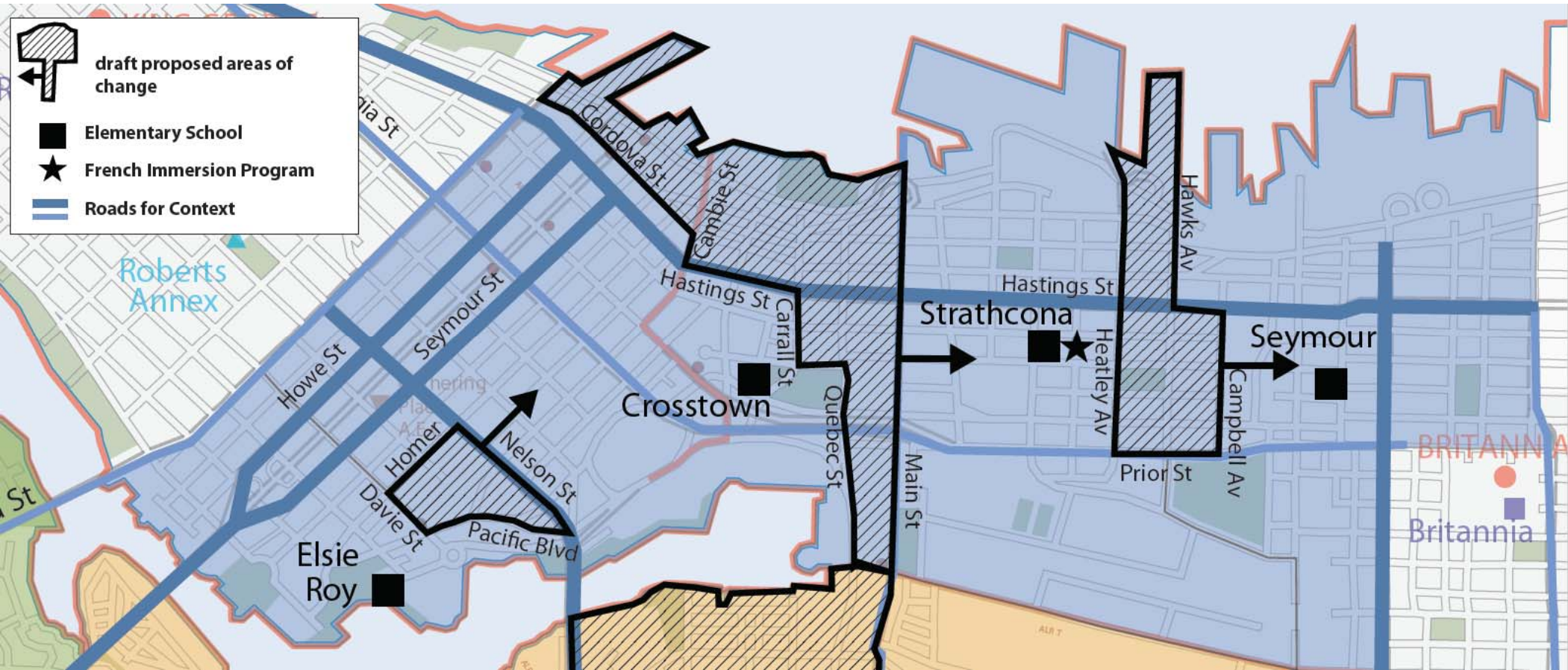

Scenario 1 Boundary Changes

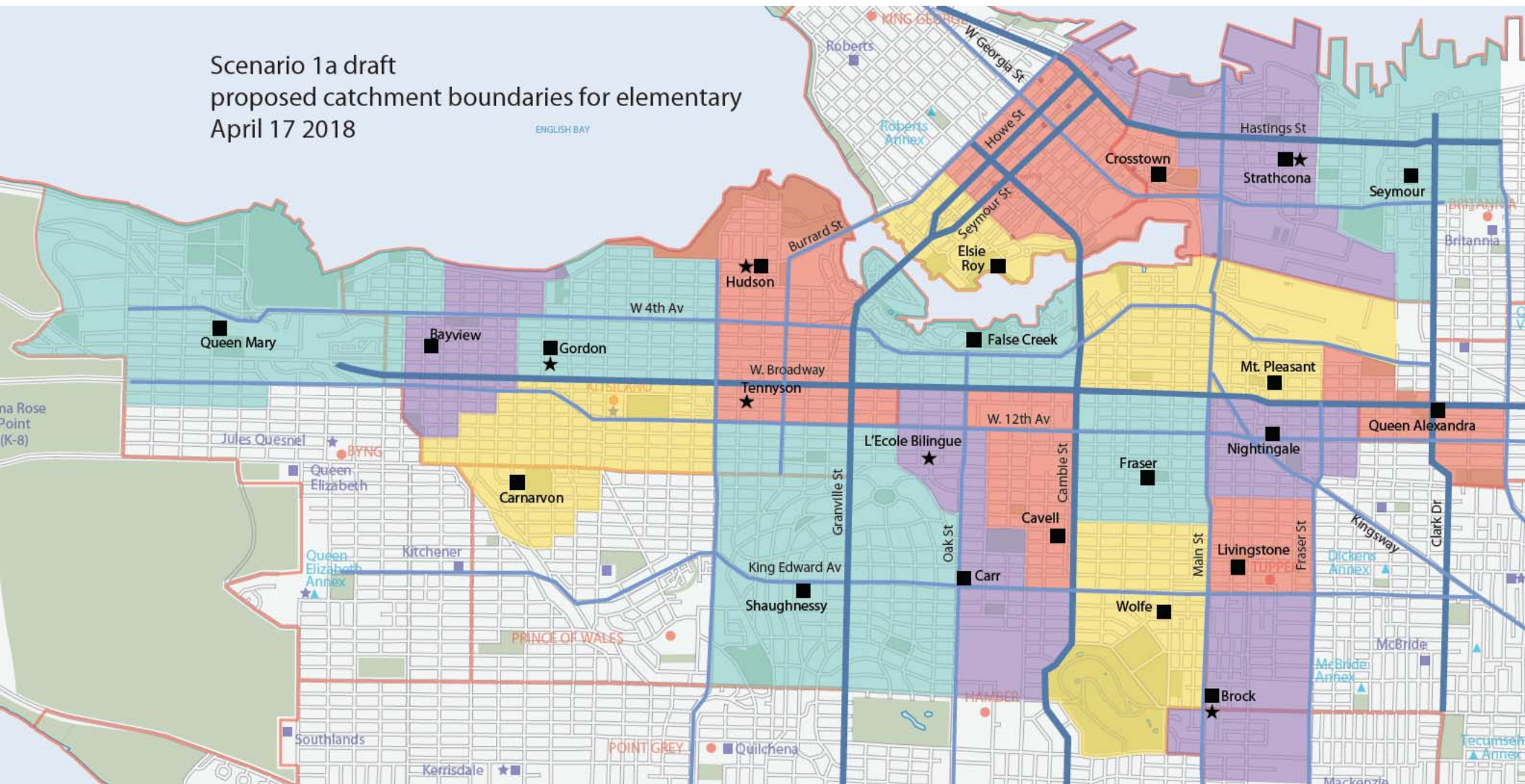
