



## Eric Hamber Secondary School - Ministry of Education 2018 District Scholarship Application Form

The District/Authority Scholarships recognize graduating BC students for excellence in their chosen area of interest or strength. These scholarships are intended to provide tuition assistance to students pursuing post-secondary education.

To be considered for a \$1,250 District Scholarship, a Grade 12 Eric Hamber student must complete and submit this printed application package **directly to Ms. Jensen (Principal) no later than 3:30 pm on Thursday, May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018.** *(Please note that electronic submissions will not be accepted.)*

### Eligible students must be:

- a Canadian citizen or permanent resident (landed immigrant) at the time of registration in the school year for which the scholarship is awarded,
- a BC resident, and
- fulfill the BC Graduation requirements of either the 2004 Graduation Program by August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018.

Students may submit only **one** application package and must choose to focus on **one** of the following seven areas of achievement:

- Indigenous Languages and Culture (Demonstrated at school or in the community)
- Fine Arts (e.g., Visual Arts, Dance, Drama, Music)
- Applied Design, Skills, and Technologies (e.g., Business Ed, Technology Ed, Home Economics)
- Physical Activity (e.g., Athletics, Dance, Gymnastics, not limited to Physical Education)
- International Languages International Languages Curriculum or External Assessments, including AP and IB courses
- Community Service (Volunteer Activity), which includes awareness of local and global issues and cultural issues
- Technical and Trades Training (e.g., Woodwork, Automotive, Robotics, Mechanics, Culinary Arts, Coding )
