King George Mini School is a District Enriched Program offered by the Vancouver School Board. In collaboration with KG staff, students and our parent community, the program has been revised for the 2017-18 school year.

New Name: King George Mini School

This name change reflects a shift towards a more generalized enriched program that includes the following highlights:

- 2-Year Cohort (Gr. 8 and 9) within a minimum of 4 academic subjects, and automatic enrollment in the International Baccalaureate Middle Years Program
- Focused on developing collaborative, creative, critically thinking communicators with a global perspective
- Opportunities for Leadership
- Opportunities for Community Involvement
- Purposeful use of Educational Technology
- 30 students

Application Process:

The Vancouver School Board requires all applicants for Mini schools to write a District Alternative Programs Test. This test is being offered November 5th at King George from 1pm to 4pm. On-line Registration is required for this test which consists of Math, English and Cognitive Skills components.

Please note that the test does not register you for admission to King George Mini School. Students writing the test will have the option of selecting their top three choices for District Programs. In addition to the District test, students must also:

1. Complete a KG Mini School paper application – available online or at King George
2. Provide a photocopy of the grade 7 first term report card (with teacher comments)
3. Participate in a KG Mini School interview
