

# LORD NELSON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SUPPLIES

Dear Families,

The Vancouver Board of Education charges a School Fee of \$25/per student which covers the cost of providing each child with a supply of pencils, erasers and paper. Art supplies including construction paper, poster board, paint and photocopied materials are also provided by the school throughout the year.

Additional and individual supplies are always welcome and we appreciate your cooperation in sending your child with the following suggested items. Please note that in September, your child's teacher may request additional items.

**Please LABEL all belongings brought to school including clothing items!**

## **GRADE K-1**

- 1 complete change of clothes (socks, underwear, pants and top) \* in case of rainy day or bathroom accidents
- 1 pair of 'Inside shoes' that a child is able to put on and take off independently

## **GRADE 1-3**

- 1 package of pencils (Ideally blue Staedler)
- 3 large glue sticks
- 4 low odor dry erase markers
- 1 box of facial tissues
- 1 pair of extra inside running shoes that your child can put on/tie independently

## **GRADE 4-7**

- 1 soft pouch pencil case
- 10 good quality pencils (HB, non-mechanical)
- 2 soft white erasers
- 2 blue ball-point pens
- 2 red ball-point pens for marking
- 1 metric ruler (wooden, no metal edge)
- 2 large glue sticks
- 1 pair good quality scissors (e.g. Fiskars 7" cut-rite, no plastic blades)
- 1 package pencil crayons
- 1 package felt pens
- 1 highlighter pen – yellow
- 2 packages of ruled refill paper (lined) – hole-punched (400 sheets)
- 7 Duo-tangs with labels – (red, green, blue, yellow, black)
- 1 pocket Dictionary
- 1 box facial tissues

## **Plus \*Grade 6 & 7 only:**

- 2 2" Binders with dividers
- 1 Calculator
- 1 Combination lock for locker (no Key Locks please)
- 1 Collins Robert French/English Dictionary
- 1 package of graph paper
- 1 Geometry set
