SCHOOL OPENING PROCEDURES

OPENING DAY - TUESDAY, 2018 SEPTEMBER 4 - GRADE 8 students report to the auditorium @ 1:00 pm. After our welcome assembly, student volunteers/leaders will lead activities and bring all students to their homerooms. Students will be at school until approximately 3:00 pm.

OPENING DAY - TUESDAY, 2018 SEPTEMBER 4 - GRADE 9 @ 9:00 am, Grade 10 @ 10:00 am, Grade 11 @ 11:00 am & Grade 12 @ 12:00 noon students report to the auditorium at their above scheduled time. Students will attend homerooms right after their welcome assembly. Homeroom class lists will be posted on the main hall bulletin boards.

GENERAL SCHOOL FEES

GRADUATION FEE - \$220 - includes the Valedictory Fee (Ceremony) - \$110 and the Dinner/Dance - \$110. See attached Fee Schedule.

Locks are available for purchase in the office for \$10.00 each.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS should report to the school counselling department between 9:00 am and 2:00 pm on **THURSDAY, 2018 AUGUST 30**.

WHERE AND HOW NEWLY ARRIVED STUDENTS TO CANADA REGISTER – All newly arrived students to Canada are to register at the District Reception and Placement Centre, 1000 East 59th Avenue (Moberly Elementary School, East Wing Entrance) between 8:30 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Monday to Friday.

WHERE AND HOW NEW STUDENTS (ALREADY LIVING IN CANADA) REGISTER - From 2018 August 27 to 2018 August 29 new students living within the Templeton School boundaries and wishing to enroll at Templeton should make an appointment with the appropriate grade administrator by phoning 604-713-8984. The parent or legal guardian must personally attend when registering a student and present proof of Vancouver residency, an official birth certificate for the student, applicable immigration and citizenship papers and, if available, the last report card. Original documentation is required.

LOCKERS

Each student is assigned an individual locker.

- Grade 8 students will be assigned an individual locker near their homeroom class. Students are to use only the locker assigned to them by their homeroom teacher. When payment for the locks is received the student will receive the lock.
- Grade 8, 9, 10 and 11 students will be assigned an individual locker near their homeroom class. These students are to use only the locker assigned to them by their homeroom teacher.
- Grade 12 students may select a locker on the Main Floor East. This selection must be recorded with the office on Tuesday, August 28 between 8:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m.

Lockers are the property of the school, but are loaned to students for storage of jackets, lunches and textbooks. **NO VALUABLES SHOULD BE LEFT IN LOCKERS SINCE THE SCHOOL HAS NO INSURANCE FOR LOCKER THEFTS. NO STUDENT IS TO SHARE A LOCKER WITH ANOTHER STUDENT. *Should a student find it absolutely necessary to bring a large sum of money or valuable item(s) to school, please bring these items to the office for safekeeping until the end of the day.***
