

Templeton's Senior Reach for the Top team wins bronze

Congratulations to Templeton Senior Reach for the Top team who won the bronze medal at the 2017 provincial championship tournament!

The Titans had their eyes on the podium as they arrived at York House, the host school for the tournament. Standing in their way were Collingwood, St Michaels, York House, University Transition, and South pointe schools, their preliminary round opponents. After five intense wins, the Titans finished 4th in the standings out of 25 teams, setting them up for potential success in the playoff round.
