## **Announcement: Templeton Secondary — Immunization Clinic #2 — May 29<sup>th</sup> 2019**

Dear Students,

On Wednesday, May 29th, 2019, eligible students will have the opportunity to receive immunizations at school:

- Students with active consents on file will receive a “Notice of School Immunization Clinic” letter informing parents of the upcoming date—no further action is required.
- Students who are eligible for immunizations will receive a “Consent for School Immunization” form—please have a parent sign and return the consent form ASAP. If we do not have a complete record, please attach a photocopy of immunization records, and we will only give those that are still needed.
- Students in any grade, without 2 documented doses of MMR vaccine, may request an MMR dose at the May 29th clinic. Students need to bring a letter or immunization records to prove eligibility. Students or parents may contact Templeton’s Public Health Nurse in advance of the clinic to confirm eligibility.
