Take Our Kids to Work Day (TOKW) is a national program that began in 1994. On **Wednesday, November 14th 2018**, Grade 9 students at UHill and across Canada are encouraged to spend the day out in the world of work under the supervision of a parent, relative or family friend.

The purpose of TOKW day is to help Grade 9 students begin to make connections between school and the world of work and their own futures. It also serves as an opening for dialogue between students and their parents, or another working adult, about career development.


- Parent/Guardian Consent Form **Due: November 2nd 2018**
