### New Registration Process

With the opening of school registration for the 2019-20 school year on November 1<sup>st</sup>, the VSB will be implementing a new online registration service for parents. The registration process will have two steps: Step 1: Complete the online registration process at [vsbapplynow.vsb.bc.ca](http://vsbapplynow.vsb.bc.ca). Print out the completed registration form.

Step 2: Bring the completed registration form along with the required documents to your catchment school.
