Dear Families;

I hope you have had a chance to take a look at the Kindness Tree in the main hall-it is wonderful to see all the acts of kindness which has made it bloom. It has been a busy month as well with 100 day, the Year of the Rooster and skating. Thank you so much for your support of these events, which enrich life here at the school. By Spring Break every class will have been skating 3 times.

Our library is going to be participating in a pilot of a new system that will be implemented in all schools in the fall. To support the conversion between systems, all materials signed out from the library are due Friday March 3rd. We appreciate your help in tracking down all items signed out from the library and ensuring they are returned March 3rd.

Our basketball season wrapped up with our Senior Boys, Junior Boys and Junior Girls finishing the season of regular play, and the Senior Girls participating in the City playoffs. Thank you to the parent coaches and many staff who sponsored these teams.

This week choir is starting again, thanks to Mr. Mathewson. It will be on Wednesday mornings at **8:15 AM, in the music room**. First practice will be this **Wednesday, March 1st**. 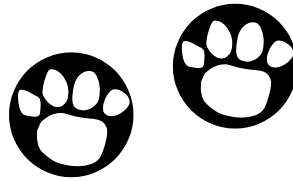
